Remembering Our Babies During the Holidays

I'm writing this article one week following our (Dallas/Fort Worth) $18^{\rm th}$ annual Walk to Remember, and M.E.N.D.—Houston's 9th annual Walk to Remember. Over the past several days I have viewed numerous beautiful pictures of both of these ceremonies on Facebook. I especially love seeing the photos of the absolutely breathtaking balloon release, as each balloon represents one of our little ones flying to heaven. The mementos displayed on the memory tables are bittersweet. I smile at some and wipe away tears while looking at others. The main objective of this ceremony is remembering and acknowledging our babies who died too soon. Since we cannot make memories with our babies' milestones, such as their first smiles, waves, and words, we must make our memories with them by collecting special keepsakes such as pictures, sonogram images, blankets, stuffed animals, Walk ornaments, etc. As the holidays near, we as parents have a need to acknowledge and remember our babies during this time of year, which oftentimes requires creativity from us, since our babies are obviously not here for family pictures around the dinner table or sitting on Santa's lap.

This will be my 20th holiday season without our Jonathan. I remember our first Thanksgiving - just five short months after his stillbirth. Oh, how angry I was that Thursday in November! I dared anyone to ask me to rattle off all I was thankful for. Even though I had my little four-year-old son and loving husband by my side, I was bitter and mad. Now, 19 years later, I can honestly say I am so thankful for Jonathan and the little baby I miscarried 6 1/2 years later. I'm thankful for what their short lives have taught me, how their losses have molded me, and for what the Lord created with M.F.N.D. out of my sorrow. Some day when I'm in heaven with them, I hope my fellow loss moms will remember my children in heaven and be thankful, too, for what came from their deaths.

My pregnancy with Jonathan was confirmed a few days before Christmas in 1994. Taking advantage of the after-Christmas sales, I purchased four new stockings, excitedly knowing I'd get to hang an additional one the following year and wanting them all to match. When Christmas rolled around a few months after Jonathan's stillbirth, I remembered the new stockings with tags still on them up in the attic. I could barely muster the strength and energy to go through my decorations, knowing I would see these four new stockings. As I pulled them from the box, it felt natural and right to hang all four on our mantel, as if Jonathan were with us. I could not bear the thought of packing up one of the unused stockings and putting it back in the attic. I didn't care if anyone thought it was weird or morbid. For several years we kept this tradition of hanging his stocking on our mantel in his memory and to acknowledge his place in our family. But over time, I felt okay about not hanging it on the mantel, and instead it hangs from a large angel's fingertips in my entryway. Likewise, I have a tiny stocking that hangs from another angel's fingers in my office in memory of Baby Mitchell, who was miscarried during the holidays in 2001. We also have numerous tree ornaments in our babies' memories, and I have what I call, "my M. □. N. D. tree" in my office, which contains all the ornaments I've collected from the Walk. All these things I do to keep our babies' memories alive during the holidays.

This may be your first holiday season without your baby or, like me, your 20th or more. Whichever the case, never feel embarrassed or not permitted to remember and acknowledge your sweet little one. Creatively incorporate your child's memory and existence in family holiday traditions. Thank the Lord for that little life, and rejoice that one day because of Whose birth we celebrate, we will see them again!


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Tulsa Balloon Release

Six Tips to Cope with Grief During the Holidays

The holidays can be an especially difficult time for parents who have lost their children. So many holiday routines and activities revolve around the gathering of family and friends. Yet, bereaved parents may not feel up for celebrating as usual or embracing holiday traditions that they have in the past. Instead of feeling a sense of loss over what the holidays were supposed to be, we can take this as an opportunity to recreate what they will be for our families from now on. The following are tips for enjoying your holidays in the face of grief:

Simplify

- o Don't expect to do everything you have in the past. Pick and choose what you're up for. This will give you the chance to think about which traditions hold real meaning for you and which you have simply observed because of old habits or other people's expectations.
- o Communicate with your family and friends. They will understand if you need to "take a break" from past expectations. Let them know what your plans are and what you might need from them in return.

Honor Your Family

- o You most certainly had hopes and expectation for what the holidays would be like. And now things have changed. It is alright to acknowledge that loss.
- o Many holiday traditions like gift giving hold special significance for parents and children. It can be hard to think of yourself as a parent when your child has died. Be sure to remember the many gifts you gave your little one while they were with you and the gifts they gave to you.

Make Room for Your Feelings

- o Slow down and allow yourself time to think about and remember your baby.
- o Talk about your child. Let other people know how you want your child to be talked about and remembered by showing them with your words and actions.

Create New Traditions

- o Holidays mark special milestones in a family's life. Think about how you will remember the life of your child in your family's history and traditions.
- o Change the focus of your celebration. Revisit why you celebrate a particular holiday and what its significance is in your life. This can give traditions and rituals a renewed depth of meaning.

Be Generous with Others

- o Do things that help you feel connected to the people you love. Spend time with the people you want to be with. Nurture those relationships.
- o Give of your time, talents and skills. Sharing can lift spirits and ease burdens.

Be Generous with Yourself

- o Expect that you will feel sad sometimes. Or angry. Or alone. These are all appropriate feelings and are an acknowledgement of the intense love you hold for your child.
- o Allow yourself to be happy. There is nothing selfish about celebrating or feeling joy. The capacity for joy is what connects us to each other. It's what the holidays are all about.

Erika Goyer is the mother of three boys and a family support navigator with Hand to Hold. Her oldest son Carrick Michael was born at 27 weeks gestation and weighed 1 pound, 14 ounces. Carrick died soon after his birth due to complications of prematurity. Erika went on to have two more high-risk pregnancies and two healthy sons, one of whom has developmental delays.

I murmured a thanks to my little bean for keeping the morning sickness at bay so I could enjoy the feast and keep my secret. I enjoyed a weekend of naive bliss, believing this was the best Thanksgiving I had ever had. Four days later I was in the emergency room with a ruptured ectopic pregnancy, and holidays would never be the same.


It's quite the paradox, trying to fit in the season of thankfulness and giving with the pain and ache of loss. That first Christmas, I enjoyed a day with family only to come home and completely break down when I realized this was the day we had planned on announcing our pregnancy. Last year I found myself jealously eyeballing the kiddie table. I moved Rylan's Christmas ornament a dozen times until it was in the "perfect spot" on the tree. I've already felt the sting of grief as I realized Rylan's birthday is on Thanksgiving this year.

But these holidays are about family. I may now be mingling new traditions with the old ones in my search for a new normal, but ultimately, it is just another season. It is just another milestone I must pass over. If it were not for the support of my family, I cannot imagine how much more I would have hurt. Shutting them completely out during a time that is set aside to bring us together is no way to thank them, and no way to heal. My holidays may never be as happy. There may not be as much joy now that I coincide a heavenly birthday with trips to Grandma's. We may no longer joke about baby food or spend a lot of time discussing how pregnant someone is getting. But 'tis the season for bringing everyone together, and I am so thankful that my family understands that includes me and our heavenly little bean.


